**Chairperson of the Conference Council, 2-year Term**

The Chairperson of the Conference Council shall preside at all meetings of the Conference Council, the Executive Council, and the Aha Pae`aina. The Chairperson shall, by virtue of office, preside over all of the meetings of the members of the Hawai`i Conference Foundation and shall be a member of the Foundation Board of Trustees and, if applicable, its Executive Committee. The Chairperson shall make an annual report to the Conference, shall perform such other duties as the Conference Council may prescribe and shall be an ex-officio member, without vote, of all committees of the Conference Council. The Chairperson shall attend the General Synod as an Associate Delegate of the Conference.

**Secretary, 2-year Term**

The Secretary shall keep or cause to be kept a permanent, accurate and legible record of all meetings and transactions of the Conference, the Conference Council and the Executive Council and shall perform such other duties as usually pertain to that office. The Secretary shall distribute or cause to be distributed to the Conference Council, the Executive Council and all the members of the Conference, as defined in Article I, the minutes of the annual, regular and special meetings of the Conference, the Conference Council and the Executive Council.

**At-Large Youth/Young Adult, 2-year Term**

Member of a HCUCC church, thirty years of age or younger upon election, serving two-year staggered terms, up to a maximum of two terms, and elected by the Aha Pae`aina.

The Justice and Witness Missional Team Chairperson presides at all meetings of the Justice and Witness Missional Team and shall be a member of the Board of Directors. The thrust of Justice and Witness is to help the Hawaii Conference become a reconciling community by nurturing communities that are able to recognize brokenness, confession, repentance, forgiveness, and healing.
