He returned to the Local Church pastorate in 2007, but has continued to serve in different capacities in the U.S., Military. His portfolio focuses on working with Committees on Ministry to accession Army, Navy, and Air Force chaplains. Reverend Boyd is married and has two grown children and three grandchildren.
