WHAT

WHO

10 youth between 6th-12th grade and 2 adult leaders, Jack Belsom and Jeannie Thompson, who will provide guidance and transportation throughout June 6-8 and will chaperone the Youth Stewards. The first 10 to register would be accepted provided there are no more than 2 youth from any one local congregation. Those youth may be their congregation's youth delegate.

WHEN

June 6-8, 2019. Initial team building and training to occur Thursday, June 6. Participate and serve during the 'Aha Pae'āina June 7-8.

WHERE

Youth Stewards will be meeting and sleeping at Nu'uaniu Congregational Church. Thursday will be spent on that campus. Friday Youth Stewards will join delegates and visitors at Kaumakapili for the morning worship, 'Aha Makua, workshops, and Taste of O'ahu. Friday evening will provide time to meet the Conference Minister candidate and meet with the Young Adult Fellowship to decide on input during the plenary on Saturday and to review plans for Saturday morning worship. Saturday belongings will be transferred to Kaumakapili, and Youth Stewards will depart with delegates following lunch.

HOW MUCH

Youth Stewards will pay \$25 each to participate. That will include airfare where required, ground transportation, food, 'Aha Pae'āina registration, and 2 t-shirts (to identify them as Youth Stewards on Friday and Saturday).
